



Distance Learning Camp Specialist

Part-Time; 30 Hours per week

Seasonal education staff needed for the distance learning children's camps. Typical activities include guiding and facilitating activities, participating in museum events, assisting in instruction, monitoring program spaces, recording data and providing supervision for children. This position requires self-directed persons who have good classroom management skills and enjoy working with children.

Term and Hours

Work will be conducted from August until May, but applicants with shorter terms of availability will be considered. Most work is scheduled Monday – Friday. Distance Learning Camp Specialists typically work 30 hours per week.

Qualifications

Qualified candidates will be in pursuit or possess a four-year degree in education, history, anthropology, biology, earth sciences, or environmental education and/or have relevant experience. Candidates must possess a valid driver's license and good driving record.
